Subdivision Summit

The University City City Manager has extended the Trustees an invitation to a city-wide Subdivision Summit on September 27.

Maintenance changes

The City has established a fee for dumping at the City Dump. John will limit drops to 1-2 per week. New fee of \$30 per dump. Trustees will look at restricting street sweeping due to 4 dumps per sweeping.

Islands and walk ways on Campus Walk and Varsity Walk will be maintained by John Huston as needed but homeowners will be responsible for adjacent spaces.

Truck

David will research the Blue Book value of the truck versus the cost to lease a truck. The estimate received on leasing is approximately \$300/month for 60 months. The Trustees will continue to review the use of the truck and get a budget from Droege for all tree service, eliminating the need for the dump truck.
